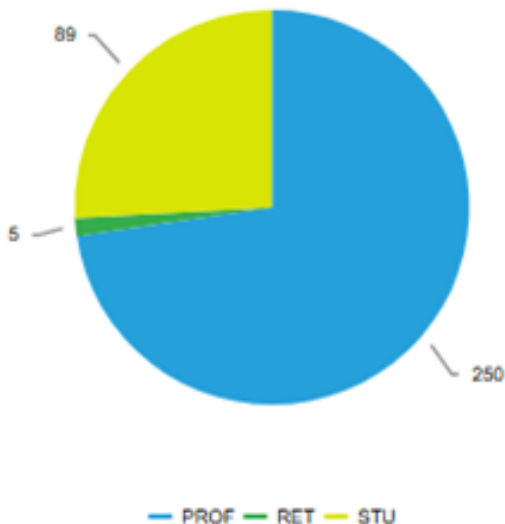


# 3.4 Membership Committee Report

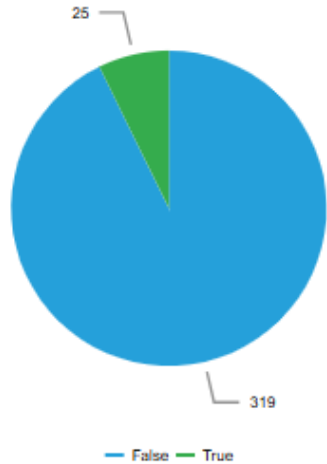

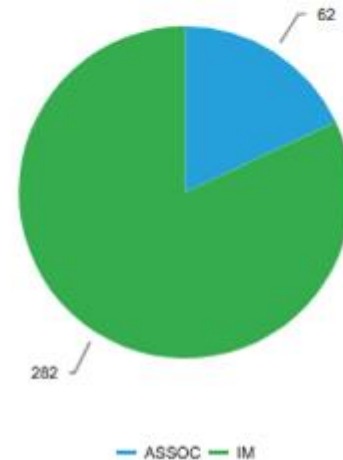
## Europe LMIC Members

The below chart displays the number of Europe Region members who reside in a high-income country (False) or a low- or middle-income country (True).



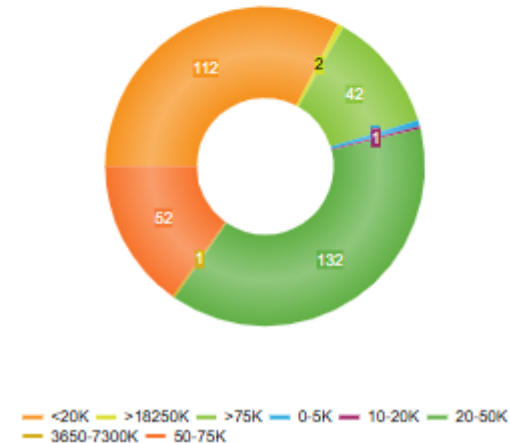
## Europe Region Members by Member Type

When members join SCB, they select a membership type. The breakdown of membership types in the Europe Region is displayed below. The membership types are Associate Member (ASSOC) and Full or Life Member (IM).



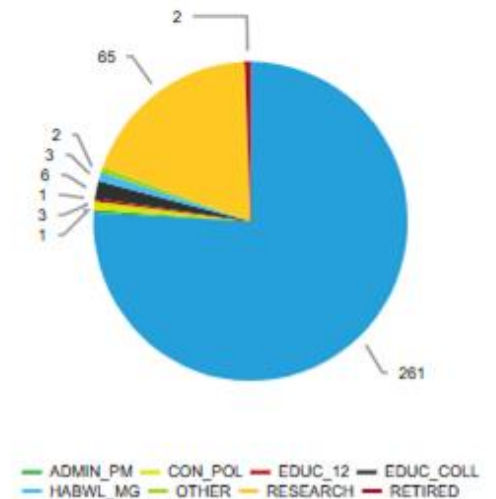
## Europe Region Member Income Tiers

Members self-report their income level when they join or renew their SCB membership, and their income level dictates their dues. This chart breaks down the number of Europe Region members who reported each income tier. The income tiers are less than USD\$20,000 per year (<20K), greater than USD\$18,250 per year (>18250K), greater than USD\$75,000 per year (>75K), USD\$0-5,000 per year (0-5K), USD\$10,000-20,000 per year (10-20K), USD\$20,000-50,000 per year (20-50K), USD\$3,650-7,300 per year (3650-7300K), and USD\$50,000-75,000 per year (50-75K).



## Europe Region Members by Functional Title

The chart below represents the number of Europe Region members who added one of a number of functional titles to their membership account. Please note that not all members added a functional title to their account - anyone who did not select a functional title is counted in the unlabeled portion of the chart. Members can only select one functional title. The functional titles are Administration and Project Management (ADMIN\_PM); Conservation Policy (CON\_POL); Education K-12/Public (EDUC\_12); Education - College/Professional (EDUC\_COLL); Habitat/Wildlife Management (HABWL\_MG); Human Dimensions (HUM\_DIM); Other (OTHER); Research (RESEARCH); and Retired (RETIRED).
